**Best Overall Affiliate Meeting Award**

Did your Affiliate hold an outstanding self-sustainable (*not sponsored/co-sponsored by IAFP*) food protection meeting which you consider 'over and above' those normally held? If so, provide the following details, if applicable, on what led to a highly successful meeting:



- The 2021 Washington Association for Food Protection's (WAFFP) September meeting was held as a hybrid event. Due to the Covid 19 pandemic, no face-to-face meeting was held in 2020 and WAFFP was prepared to move to a full virtual meeting if in-person attendance was restricted by public health officials. Fortunately, 2021 allowed for the hybrid meeting where in-person attendees and speakers and virtual attendees and speakers were able to participate together.
- 2021 was WAFFP's 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. To celebrate, we had Wineglasses with our updated logo available, and held a "Covid-safe" celebration after our banquet to toast the special event with cake.
- The annual golf tournament was held with 15 golf participants on the day prior to the educational portion of our conference. To promote friendly and fun competition, we award longest drive and closest to the pin for both male and female golfers.
- Students from Washington State University (WSU) and Oregon State University (OSU) were able to participate with research presentations and poster sessions. FDA, State and University speakers were able to participate virtually as most agencies still had no travel restrictions in place due to Covid 19.
- Supplier Presentations were included throughout the meeting and tabletop displays were physically present during the meeting so participants could interact directly with the suppliers. There were 4 Platinum Sponsors that presented Supplier presentations (Charm Sciences, Wesmar Companies, Hygiena and AFCO/Zep. Gold Sponsors included Sprague, Nether Industries, 3M and Columbia Laboratories. The Platinum Sponsors all participated in the Supplier Presentations, and both the Platinum and Gold sponsors had tabletop displays. To encourage interaction between the vendors and attendees, we have incorporated a cash drawing with vendor "passport cards".
- We have worked closely with both WSU and OSU to encourage more student attendance. This year, just prior to our Awards Banquet, we held a "Science and Cocktails" Happy Hour, allowing interaction between the students presenting posters and our attendees. Our Awards Banquet was well received, where we award golf prizes, and we announced the results of our annual meeting election of officers from the earlier business meeting. In 2021 – we were excited to have professors from both WSU and OSU on our Planning Committee.

- To raise monies for the WAFFP/Lloyd Luedecke Scholarship fund, we held a Silent Auction with various Cheeses to bid on. Several cans of aged Cougar Gold (produced by WSU Students), a large wheel of Litehouse Blue Cheese, a basket of cheese from OSU and a slab of Beechers cheese brought in additional funds for the WAFFP/Luedecke Scholarship.

- WAFFP was originally founded with roots and related membership in the Washington Dairy Industry, but our membership has expanded to other industries through the years to better reflect our states diverse food and agricultural sectors. In 2021, our attendees included 19% from Industry (Dairy, Seafood, Produce, and others) 17% Government (FDA, WSDA, Dept. of Health), 31% Suppliers/Vendors, 28% from the education sector (including students) and 3% retirees.
