Webinar at Tennessee State University

<u>Background:</u> The webinar titled "Use of the USDA - Predictive Microbiology Information Portal, Pathogen Modeling Program, and ComBase: Tools for evaluating interventions" aimed to delve into the utilization of advanced tools available through the USDA to assess and enhance food safety interventions.

<u>Objectives:</u> To elucidate the functionality and practical application of the USDA's Predictive Microbiology Information Portal, Pathogen Modeling Program, and ComBase.

<u>Agenda:</u> The agenda comprised an introduction to the predictive microbiology tools, followed by detailed demonstrations of their functionalities and case studies illustrating their application in evaluating interventions.

<u>Target Audience:</u> The webinar targeted professionals and researchers including graduate students in the field of food safety, particularly those interested in leveraging technological advancements for intervention evaluation.

Date Held: The webinar was conducted on November 3, 2023.

Number of Attendees: The webinar attracted a total of 12 attendees.

Presentation at the Institute for Thermal Processing Specialists Fall Symposium

<u>Background:</u> The presentation titled "Clostridium botulinum: Modeling for Growth and Toxin Production" was delivered at the Institute for Thermal Processing Specialists Fall Symposium. It focused on utilizing modeling techniques to understand the growth and toxin production of Clostridium botulinum, a bacterium of significant concern in food safety.

<u>Objectives</u>: The primary objective of this presentation was to explore the application of modeling approaches in predicting the growth dynamics and toxin production of Clostridium botulinum under various environmental conditions, thereby aiding in risk assessment and management strategies.

<u>Agenda:</u> The agenda encompassed an overview of Clostridium botulinum and its significance in food safety, followed by discussions on modeling methodologies and their relevance in predicting bacterial growth and toxin production.

<u>Target Audience:</u> The presentation catered to professionals specializing in thermal processing and food safety, including researchers and industry professionals involved in the prevention and control of foodborne pathogens.

<u>Date Held:</u> The presentation took place on October 17, 2023.

<u>Number of Attendees:</u> We could not get an exact count of the attendees, but it is best estimated to be around 180 attendees.
