NZAFP held its annual meeting in Hamilton, New Zealand on the 2nd of July 2024 in conjunction with the one-day annual food safety symposium organized by New Zealand Food Safety Science & Research Centre (NZFSSRC) and 3-day Annual conference of the New Zealand Institute of Food Science and Technology (NZIFST). The attendees included food safety professionals from industry, academia, regulators and students. Highlights in this year's affiliate activities were plenary presentations by Dr Michelle Danyluk, Professor of Food Safety and Microbiology in the Department of Food Science and Human Nutrition at the University of Florida, and Past President of IAFP. Her visit was kindly co-sponsored by the IAFP speaker program, NZFSSRC and NZIFST. As an esteemed international produce safety expert, Michelle spoke on food safety in diverse scenarios including extreme weather events, fresh fruit and vegetable safety, and international considerations on food safety in a changing world. She also offered her valuable insights on fresh produce safety using her research-based examples as case studies in an interactive webinar for industry and researchers from the horticulture sector. The webinar was sponsored by NZAFP and Chaired by Dr Roger Cook.

Another highlight was a mid-year virtual catch up for our members to discuss ways to increase participation and improve student involvement. The meeting highlighted that there is a need to encourage students to participate more in NZAFP and to be retained

in the food safety space (regulatory, academic or industry sectors). The potential to host American student interns early in 2026 was also discussed. Members from various areas of expertise agreed to design a package to provide a broad experience for the students in food safety and biosecurity regulatory systems, dairy and meat industries as well as Universities and Crown Research Institutes.
