The 2024 training was split jointly between field personnel and lab. The field meeting included discussions on animal drugs, positive antibiotic procedure, and SCC/Bacteria warnings and suspensions. The antibiotic portion was how to submit the correct documentation to the state when a rejected load has occurred. The field staff were then asked to walk around the room at stations with different drugs and if they are requiring vet labels, legal the way they are, or completely illegal. Lastly we discussed as a group how to properly warn and suspend based on 2 out of 4 and 3 out of 5 bacteria counts. The lab discussion revolved around how many labs are in PA, the current LEOs, website changes and more. The biggest points were made on the positive antibiotics side and how the labs need to report them. There was also a large ruling that came out about frozen deserts and how to sample hard and soft ice creams. The multidrug residue study that PDA conducted was also brought to the table and discussed with the findings coming in at 19 animal drug residues that were in 8 different drug families. Lastly it was followed up with how weigher samplers get certified. New is that there is an online knowledge test to make it easier for everyone instead of travelling to Harrisburg. We have done a very good job this past year with bringing in relevant topics to be used at both the farm and lab levels.
